## **1.0 INTRODUCTION**

West Virginia Code §11-13-16 requires **“all state, county, district, and municipal officers and agents... shall withhold payment in the final statement of... contracts until the receipt of a certificate to the effect all taxes levied or accrued... against the contractor have been paid.”**

In compliance with this provision, all West Virginia Division of Highways' (WVDOH) organizations shall obtain tax releases for municipalities before submitting a semi-final or final invoice from a consulting engineer, attorney, appraiser, a general contractor, or a contractor.

The following requirements must be met and submitted to the Finance Division when processing a tax release:

1. A tax release for each semi-final or final invoice must be obtained from all municipalities in which work was performed.
2. Municipal tax release forms or letters must be included with each submission to the Finance Division.
3. Each invoice shall be plainly marked in ink either “partial payment” or “final payment.”
4. Upon receipt of an invoice of this type, Finance Division will ensure these steps have been correctly followed.
